After completing the course, high school students are eligible to apply for an internship, where they can earn college credit and pay while learning on the job as a Nusenda intern!

Details:

CNM course: BFIN 1115 - Financial Services Career Exploration

Earn:

- → .5 high school economics or elective credit and
- → 3 business credits at CNM

This is a 12-week, late start course. Students will complete all asynchronous course work and assignments on CNM's Brightspace Management System. Fall term students have the option of synchronous in-person meetings or online meetings.

Course Option 2: Wednesdays, 3:10-5:10 p.m. Hybrid with in-person meetings at the Career Enrichment Center (CEC) - Fall term only
